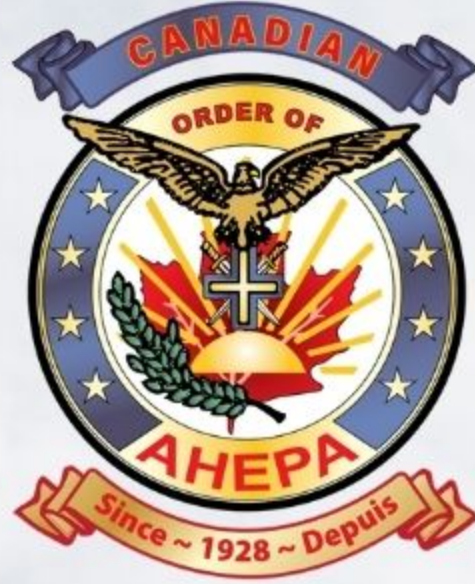

- Front page copy of Passport
- Must be at least 18 yrs. of age.
- Must be admitted to a university or recently graduated High School

Recently graduated High School students must provide a High School transcript or submit a copy of their University enrollment form or else apply for admission to Webster.
